M.A. ADMISSION (SELF FINANCING) INFORMATION AND PROCEDURE

The College invites applications for admission into **M.A. classes (self-financing)** in **Psychology, (32) Education (32), Home Science, (32) for the session, 2019-2020.**

The process of admission is exclusively on-line (Please read the instructions and view and verify the filled in Application Form before submitting it online)

Procedure of submission of Application Form

- 1- The applicant is to fill the form on line and take a printout copy of the filled in application form.
- 2- Deposit the requisite fess for application of **₹500** (non-refundable) either in cash at the college collection counter or draw an account payee bank draft for **₹500**(non-refundable) in favour of **Principal, Govt. Women's College, Baripada** payable at **Baripada**.
- 3- Submit the printout copy of the filled in application form along with other documents mentioned below at the college counter and fill up the register at the counter to record your submission **or** the printout copy of the filled in application form along with other documents mentioned below may be sent by Regd. Post /Speed post in college office address. Please write" M.A. admission application" on the top of the envelop

Date of receipt of the printout copy of the filled in application form –from 24.6.2019 (12.30pm) to last date of Application

Last Date of Application - 8.7.2019 (4.p.m.)

Documents to be attached with the print out of filled in application Form:

- a. Account Payee Bank draft /Money Receipt of fees for application (₹500)(non-refundable)
- b. Self-attested Copies of Certificates and Mark sheets (From HSC onwards)
- c. Self-attested Copy of Caste Certificate/Certificate in claim of the reservation and weightage
- d. Affix photographs where required.
- e. Two self-addressed envelops

Reservation of seats–

- For ST & SC – Govt. Norms
- For children of Ex- Serviceman - 1%
- For Differently abled persons – 3%
- Serving Defence personnel – 1%
- Children of Martyrs – 2%

In the case of non-availability of candidate from any one of the reserved categories (except ST & SC) seats will be filled up by the general candidates from the merit list.

Weightage (Sports & Games)

- A- Representing the country at International level – Direct admission
- B- Representing the state at National level – 10% weightage over and above the Hons. /pass/elective marks
- C – Representing the university at Inter-university level – 5% weightage over and above the Hons. /pass/elective marks

All certificate for claiming weightage must be countersigned by the Director of Sports, Govt. of Odisha. The weightage shall be applicable if the participation is within three years prior to the application for admission.

Eligibility and Principle of Selection

Eligibility: Only Women students passing out Three Year Degree Course Examination from a recognised University/Institution and must have concerned subject in the said Degree Course in Hons or Pass or Elective for which she is applying are eligible to apply.

Principle of Selection: Selection of candidates for admission will be made on the basis of their academic career assessment

Career Assessments: The academic career of a candidate will be assessed out of 100 marks, the breakup of which is given in table

Calculation of career Marks

For HSC and +2

Marks awarded for career = $\frac{\text{Marks Secured without extra optional}}{\text{Maximum marks without extra optional}} \times \text{Marks assigned for career}$

For +3

Marks awarded for career = $\frac{\text{Marks Secured in the subject}}{\text{Maximum marks in the subject}} \times \text{Marks assigned for career}$

In case of tie in total career assessment mark, Aggregate Marks in Degree/+3 Exam. (excluding Foundation and Ancillary Marks) will be the deciding factor

The list of selected applicants for admission will be published in our website and college notice board.

The selected applicants are required to download the intimation letter from college website. No intimation will be sent by Post.

If the number of qualified applicants for selection in subject falls eight, the admission in the concerned subject may be cancelled for the session 2019 - 20

Fees to be deposited at the time of Admission (tentative) – Course Fee (Rs5000 per semester) + Session Dues (Rs. 1800 per year) + Seminar Fees (Rs. 2000 one time). The mode and exact amount of payment will be intimated in the intimation letter for admission.
